What will we be doing at iGNiTE LTD Dundee?

It all begins in Dundee with iGNiTE LTD the week beginning Monday 30th June 2008, for four consecutive days. The precise days will be confirmed once all the iGNiTE Proformas have been completed and handed in. We will split into three groups, with each group designated a specific local organisation in Dundee to work with. Each group will be segmented into two teams, and the teams will be given specific tasks to plan and deliver as an integral part of the training. At the end of each day we will gather at a central location and share our stories, respond to any matters arising and reflect on process.

Once the iGNiTE LTD Dundee is over we will be able to determine the specific teams leading each of the iGNiTE events across Scotland. If for whatever reason you cannot make the training event in Dundee do not despair – we will have at least one other training event which will be announced by the end of May at the very latest...

PLEASE NOTE: training **IS** required if you are interested in leading iGNiTE events either in your locality or across Scotland. However there is absolutely no need to train if all you want to do is turn up to the iGNiTE events in your locality.

If you are selected for iGNiTE LTD Dundee then we will let you know latest by the second week in June. You will need to make your own way to Dundee for the training – once here we will feed and house you.
